

Uxbridge Youth Baseball Association: - 2010

Bantam Division

- Bantam Division players are turning 14 and 15.
- At this level, most players are honing baseball skills learned in prior years of play.
- Pitching, hitting, running and fielding rules are pretty much the same as in Major League Baseball.
- An inning consists of three outs or a maximum of five runs per team, with an open-scoring last inning.
- Batters may bunt
- Runners are allowed to slide and to lead off and steal bases.
- There are eight or nine defensive players in the field - six infielders and two or three outfielders.
- At the house league level, players may be rotated through the available field positions.
- Pitchers are not allowed to pitch more than two consecutive innings or three innings in a game.
- Games are at least three but normally six innings.
