PeeWee Division

- ✓ Peewee Division players are turning 12 and 13 years old in the current year and developing their baseball skills.
- ✓ Pitching, hitting, running and fielding rules are pretty much the same as in Major League Baseball.
- ✓ An inning consists of three outs or a maximum of five runs per team, with an open-scoring last inning.
- ✓ Batters are allowed to bunt
- ✓ Runners are allowed to slide into first and to lead off and steal bases.
- ✓ There are eight or nine defensive players in the field - six infielders and two or three outfielders.
- ✓ At the house league level, players are rotated through the available field positions.
- ✓ Pitchers are not allowed to pitch more than two consecutive innings or three innings in a game.
- ✓ Games are at least three and often up to five innings.
